Christ Our Savior Lutheran High School is recognized by the State of Illinois as a non-public school and is accredited by the National Lutheran School Association.

Eleven Lutheran Church Missouri Synod congregations form the association that supports *COS* and serve on our school board.

Enrollment for 2023-2024 is 23 students in grades nine to twelve. Six students are in the class of 2024. Our faculty-to-student ratio is 1:6.5.

Our CEEB and ACT code is 141858.

Christ Our Savior is a parochial high school in Randolph County, IL. In 2021, Randolph County had 30,600 residents, with 13.2% living below the poverty line. 84% of the residents are white non-Hispanic, 10.6% African American, 3,3% Hispanic, and 2.1% other ethnicities. The student body of *COS* is 96% white non-Hispanic, and 4% mixed. 48% of our students qualify for free and reduced lunch.

All classes are graded on a 4.0 grading scale: 90-100% A; 80-89% B; 70-79% C; 60-69% D; below 60% F. No classes are weighted.

Students who fail a course may recover credit by taking an online credit recovery course or repeating the course on campus.

All FFA classes and a wide variety of electives are available through online classes. Gradeeligible juniors and seniors may enroll in dual credit courses through Southeast Missouri State, Cape Girardeau, MO (SEMO).

Standardized Test Scores:

The average ACT score of our students for the last 5 years is 23.3.

Class rank is not reported to colleges.

Recent graduates have attended Southwestern Illinois College, Belleville, IL; Southern Illinois University, Carbondale, IL; University of Illinois, Champaign-Urbana, IL; Southern Illinois University, Edwardsville, IL; Concordia University, Chicago, IL; Southeast Missouri State, Cape Girardeau, MO; Missouri State University, Springfield, MO; College of the Ozarks, Point Lookout, MO; Concordia University, Seward, NE; and Concordia University, Mequon, WI.

Christ Our Savior graduates have also entered the military, gone to trade schools, and started their own businesses.
