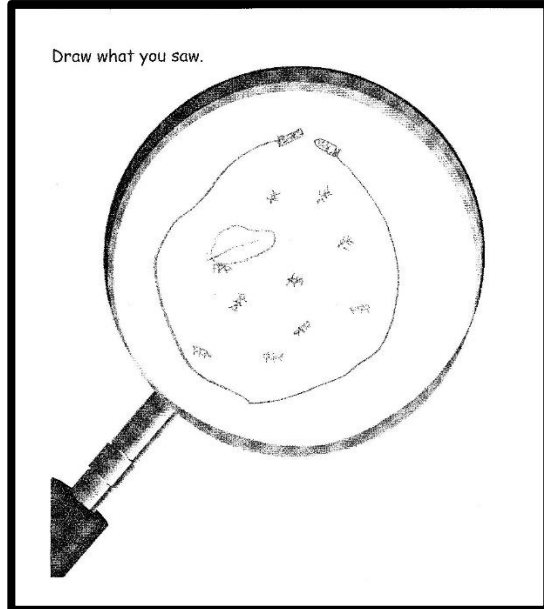
Examples

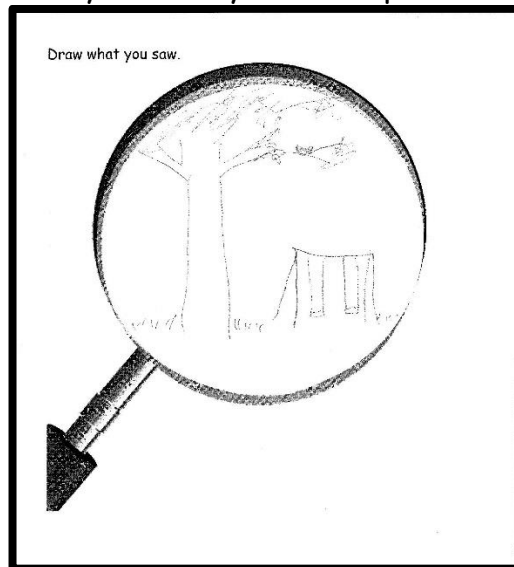


Visit someplace new with your family or just head into your backyard to explore.
