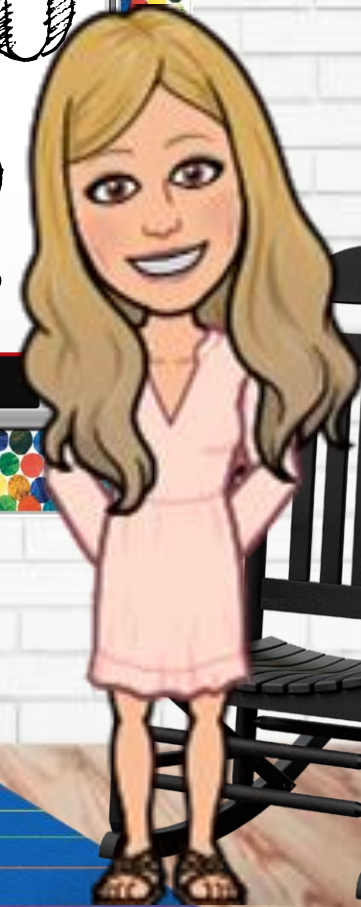

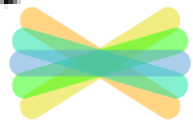

- Work should be taken out each week.

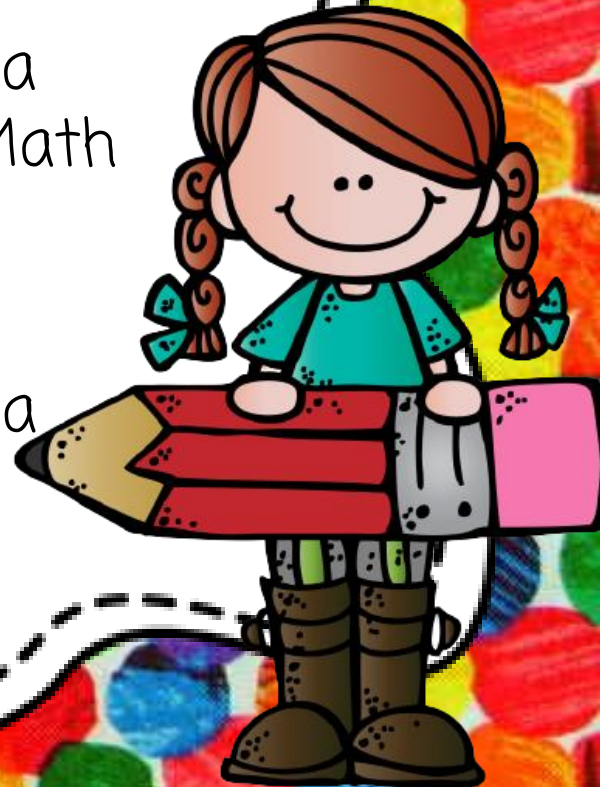


# Homework

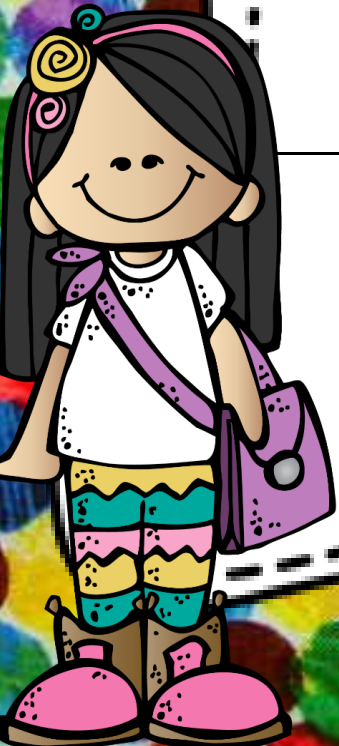

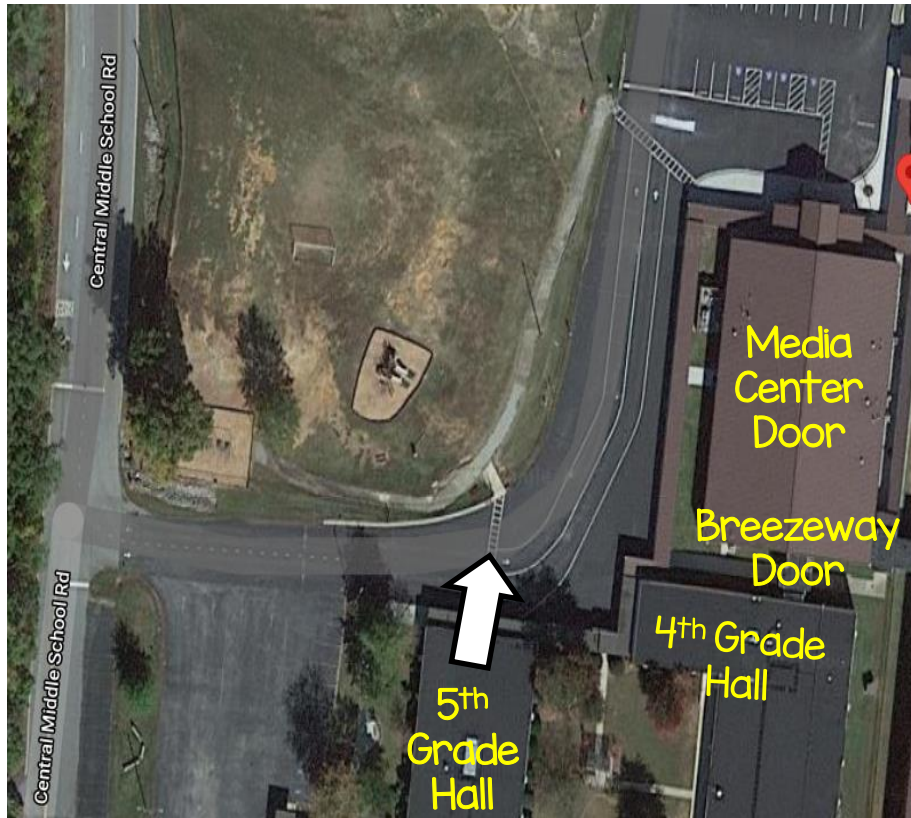

  - Ice Cream will be sold for \$1.00 on **FRIDAYS ONLY**.

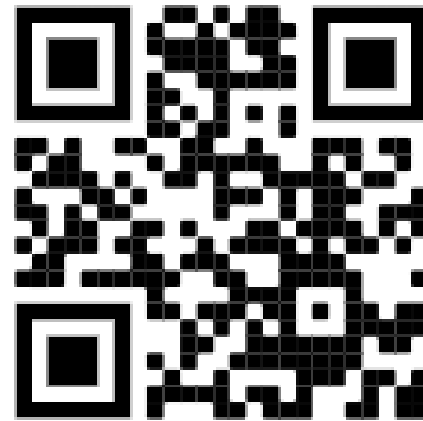

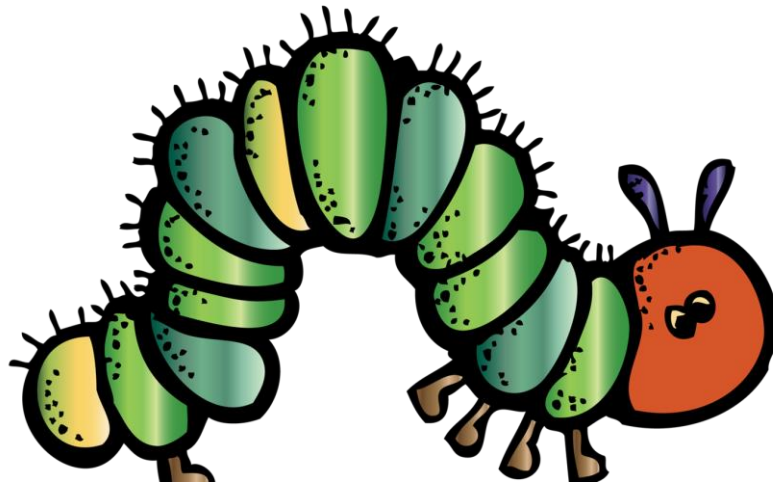
