Policy Statement

This policy is intended to act as a guide to ensure assessment of individual student progress including testing and reporting.

Assessment time will intentionally be scheduled within the school schedule for progress monitoring, and summative state assessments.

State Mandated Testing:

- Administered annually to students in grades 7-8. IEP and 504 plans will be followed for student with disabilities.
- College and Career Readiness.
 - o ILP's and state readiness testing (8th Grade only) will be administered yearly. Students will be counseled on career and college readiness throughout the year.

Progress Monitoring:

• A CCPS adopted monitoring assessment will be given three times yearly (i.e. MAP), and Common Assessments, will be used to progress monitor student achievement throughout the

year. Progress monitoring will help identify students' particular learning styles, multiple intelligences, strengths and weaknesses in core subject areas.
