For parents and students, thinking about life after high school can be daunting. Whether the plans are to participate in service, attend college or work, it is never too early to begin the (re)search to become familiar with the process. The websites listed below contain helpful information for all ages. Check them out!

For seniors that are thinking some type of college is in their future, a completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FASFA) is a form that nearly every college will require of potential students. Go to www.fafsa.gov to apply and to receive FREE help. (Do not pay for the completion of the FAFSA. This is a FREE financial aid service.) Once a FAFSA form has been completed, a college admissions counselor is the best person to help you navigate through the financial aid process. If you want to receive the most financial aid possible, fill out the FASFA form as soon as possible after your taxes have been completed.
