A One Pager Book Report is designed to let you show and tell about the book you have read in a way that is different than the standard Book Report. A One Pager Book Report is creative and unique. Use artwork and color for your pictures and text.

You may write in full sentences, paragraphs, or bullet points to tell about your book. Use colorful illustrations to show your understanding in a variety of ways.

Directions:

Use this guide to help you fill in the spaces on your One Pager Book Report.

- Title- The title of the novel
- Author- The author's name
- Main Character- Describe and draw the main character
- Supporting Character- Describe a character that was not the main character, but was important in the story.
- Genre- Was the novel fiction or non-fiction? What type?
- Setting- Describe and draw the setting. (when/where the story takes place)
- Problem- Describe the problem/conflict in the novel.
- Solution- Describe how the character solved the problem.
- Beginning- What happened in the beginning of the novel?
- Middle- What happened in the middle of the novel?
- End- What happened in the end of the novel?
- Color the "thumbs up" if you liked the book. Color the "thumbs down" if you did not like the book.
