

PARENTS RIGHT-TO-KNOW 2023-2024

Dear Parent:

In accordance with ESEA Section 1111(h)(6) *PARENTS RIGHT-TO-KNOW*, May ISD is notifying every parent of a student in a Title I school that you have the right and may request information regarding the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teacher. This information regarding the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teachers including, at a minimum, the following:

Whether the teacher has met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction.

- 1. Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived.
- 2. The baccalaureate degree major of the teacher and any other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher, and the field of discipline of the certification or degree.
- 3. Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.

If at any time your child has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher not highly qualified, the school will notify you.

At this time, May ISD currently has one elementary teacher and four junior high/ high school teachers that are working through an alternative certification program to obtain their teaching certificates. Those teachers are Tana Isbell-5th & 6th ELAR, Kendel Hopper-HS CTE, Geneva Lord-HS CTE, Wyatt Mote- JH/HS math, and Jacob Brown-JH science.

- Tana Isbell holds a Bachelor of Science from Tarleton State University. She is currently in the iteachTEXAS program.
- Kendel Hopper holds a Bachelor of Science in Ag from Tarleton State University and is working on a Master's Degree in Ag and Consumer Science. He has passed all of his content tests and is in the last phase of his internship from teachTEXAS.
- Wyatt Mote holds a bachelor's degree in Kinesiology from Texas Tech University. He has passed all of his content tests and is in the last phase of his internship from teachTEXAS.
- Jacob Brown holds a bachelor's degree in Kinesiology from Tarleton State University. He has passed all of his content tests and is in the last phase of his internship from teachTEXAS.

• Geneva Lord holds a bachelor's degree in Agriculture Communication from Texas Tech University.
