SMS Uniform Policy 2024-2025

SHIRTS:

Shirts are to be polo/golf/ button up style (short or long sleeves). Shirts must be tucked in, and collars must be visible.

6th Grade **GRAY** only

7th Grade **LIGHT BABY BLUE** only (no teal or agua)

8th Grade **NAVY BLUE** only

Grade level t-shirts issued (at registration and in front office) only by SMS may be worn ANY school day. School spirit shirts (sold by various clubs) may be worn on **FRIDAYS** only.

Undershirts should be white, gray, light baby blue, navy or black.

BOYS PANTS/SHORTS:

Khaki/tan/navy uniform pants/shorts with no holes, tears, or rips. Pants must have belt loops. **No jeans/denim or sagging pants. Shorts must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.**

GIRLS PANTS/SHORTS:

Khaki/tan/navy uniform pants/shorts/capris with no holes, tears, or rips. Pants must have belt loops. **No skirts or skorts. Shorts must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee. No jeans/denim, leggings, or jeggings.**

Belts

Belts must be worn. No oversized belt buckles. Belts should be brown or black.

SOCKS & SHOES:

Socks MUST BE WORN. No designs deemed inappropriate by administrators.

Tennis shoes of any color.

NO boots (of any kind), sandals, open toe or open back shoes, crocs, slides or slippers.

OUTERWEAR: *No logos except Semmes Middle School

SOLID Navy, black, baby blue or gray jackets/sweatshirts. NO hoodies will be allowed! NO denim jackets!

P.E. UNIFORMS:

Students will not be required to dress out this year. However, students who choose to dress out must wear schoolissued P.E. uniform during their P.E. class. P.E. uniforms may be purchased during registration.

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- NO caps, hats, sweatbands, stocking caps, bandanas, headwraps, or any other type of head covering.
 NO headbands over 3 inches in width.
- NO facial piercings. Piercings are ONLY allowed in earlobes.
- NO choker-style necklaces.
- ID badges must be worn at all times attached to the student's collar with picture visible.
- Plastic water bottles ONLY. No metal cups and/or water bottles will be allowed.
- Clear bookbags ONLY.
- Also unacceptable: Anything deemed inappropriate or disruptive by the administration.
