The Rotary Club of Wyoming is a service organization comprised of local business and professional people who believe that community service is an honorable means for attaining success and happiness in their personal, business and community lives.

OBJECT OF ROTARY

The Object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:

- FIRST: The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;
- SECOND: High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;
- THIRD: The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life;
- FOURTH: The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

As Rotarians, we strive to follow our FOUR WAY TEST in what we say and do:

1. Is it the TRUTH?
2. Is it FAIR to all concerned?
3. Will it build GOOD WILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?

The Rotary Club of Wyoming Scholarship selection **requirements**:

- Applicant must be graduating Wyoming Are Senior with a GPA of at least 80 and actively involved in community service and has been accepted to a trade, technical or vocational school; a community college or a 4 year college or university.
- Actively involvement in community service
- Minimum of 500 word essay detailing what community service projects they have been involved in and explaining what personal impact that community service has had on them. The essay must also include specific examples on how they see themselves continuing to help others throughout their lifetime.
Selected finalists will be interviewed by the Rotary Club of Wyoming Scholarship Committee. One award of \$1000 and 2 awards of \$500 will be presented.
