Personal Items

We ask that you send a change of clothes in a Ziploc bag that will be kept in your child's book bag in case of any accidents. Please label the Ziploc bag with your child's name. If your child has an accident, we will send home that set of clothes to be washed, and we ask that you replace that set with a new one for your child's book bag. Please be sure to update this emergency bag as your child grows and the seasons change. We thank you in advance for your help with this!

Transportation

If your child has any changes in transportation, it MUST be sent in writing on the day the change is to occur. If a written note is not sent with your child, he/she will be sent home using his/her regular daily transportation. No changes or sign outs will be allowed after 2:00 p.m. daily.

Money

All money that comes to school (PTA membership, school fees, pictures, etc.) needs to be in an envelope/Ziploc bag with your child's name on it, along with what the money is to be used for and the amount, clearly labeled on the front. This will help us make sure the money gets to the right place quickly!

Birthdays

You may send individually wrapped store bought items to school for your child's birthday. Please send enough items for 20 children. The items should be sent to school 5 days BEFORE your child's birthday so they may be quarantined prior to the birthday.

Attendance

Assessments

Your child will be assessed this year using anecdotal records, teacher observations, checklists, performance assessments and standardized tests to document your child's progress. Over the course of the year, your child will be assessed on the following:

- KRA (Kindergarten Readiness Assessment)
- Letter Identification
- Knowledge of letter sounds
- Reading fluency and comprehension
- Number identification
- Counting objects up to 20
- Sight word recognition
- CVC words/blending
- Writing their name
- Rhyming words
- Orally counting to 100
- Adding and subtracting within 10
- Fountas and Pinnell reading level
- Writing
- MAP Testing (Measure of Academic Progress)
MAP is a standardized test given 3 times a year.
- STAR Testing (Standardized Test for the Assessment of Reading)
Star is a standardized test given many times a year. Star assesses reading, math and early literacy skills and is given several times throughout the year.
