
2024-2025 **Yearbooks** already ordered are anticipated to be delivered to the HS the beginning of June.



A 2025-26 Out of District Application for Admission is also required for all students living outside the Dawson Springs district to register. The district boundaries are the four bridges leading out of town.

Completed Out of District forms must be submitted to the DS Board Office as soon as possible to reserve placement for next school year. A form is included on page 9. If you have any questions or need



help accessing your Parent Portal account, call your child's school office or Crystal at the Board of Education office @ 270-797-3811.

All students entering 6th grade are required by Ky. State Law to have a 6th grade physical exam



and a current valid KY immunization certificate. Immunizations that are required for all students entering the 6th grade include (1) T-Dap, (2) varicella and (1) meningococcal. Your

child will have to have these immunizations once they turn 11 years of age. A sports physical will not be accepted as their 6th grade school physical. Please make arrangements with either the school clinic or your family physician. Your child will not be allowed to enter 6th grade without his/her physical and their updated immunization certificate.

Summer business hours for the DS BOE office

will be from 7:30am to 3:00pm Monday - Friday beginning June 1. Normal office hours will resume on August 1.
