Mrs. Rosalik will update her staff regarding the three construction projects on ACES:

- The two pull-out rooms for Speech and OT are complete.
- In preparation for our solar installation, the 600 building will be getting a new roof. Construction on the roof will begin next week, likely Tuesday, the 31st. Teachers advised this will be a construction zone, and the air conditioning may be occasionally and temporarily interrupted. The new roof is slated to be completed before the first day of school!
- New concrete curbing and sand has been installed in the primary playground. The
  curbing is around the jungle gym and will help to contain the proper amount of sand
  under the structure. It will be painted bright yellow before the start of school and to
  please be aware that the curbing is higher than it was before and it now extends around
  the sides.

Tanque Verde Loop Rd., Bldg#1 Tucson AZ 85749 effective August 27, 2010 and Emily Gray Junior High School is located at 11150 E. Tanque Verde Rd., Tucson AZ 85749 effective August 11, 2011.
