Full Opening for Face-to-Face Instruction for 2023-2024 School Year

Learning Model

- Continue to encourage social distancing.
- Full day instruction with all students in the building.
- Weekly Staff meetings on Wednesdays after school.

Safety/Cleaning for COVID-19 Prevention and Management

- All staff and student symptoms are monitored at the building entrance by the office staff to ensure safety of all students and staff. Temperatures are taken as necessary.
- Use of face masks optional inside the building following CDC guidelines.
- Masks optional at recess inside and outside.
- Masks are provided by the school if necessary.
- Regular daily cleaning taking place.
- Extra wipe-downs of all common surfaces- door knobs, railings, bathrooms, sinks, coffee area, etc.
- Visitors are now allowed in the building.
- If a child is sick with any symptoms, parents are contacted. Students are only covid tested with request from parent/guardian. Students are then sent home if symptoms are likely to spread sickness.
- If a staff member is sick, they stay home if they have symptoms that are likely to spread sickness.
- Confirmed cases follow CDC school closure recommendations.
