CLASSROOM NEWS

We will continue Unit 2, Lesson 2 this week:

Phonics- Sounds of g and j, the floss rule (letters f, l, s, and z are doubled in words after short vowels)

Comprehension Strategies- making connections, making inferences, summarizing, fact and opinion, point of view

High-Frequency Word- look, was, what, big, got

Vocabulary Words- company, glanced, disagree, situations, tough, lend, suggests, solutions

Writing- Narrative Writing

Grammar- Possessive Nouns (words that show ownership- the dog's bone)

Dictation- On Friday there will be a dictation test. The teacher will call out some of the sounds listed above and the students will write the corresponding letters to spell the words and sentence. **Students will also spell two red words: look, was**

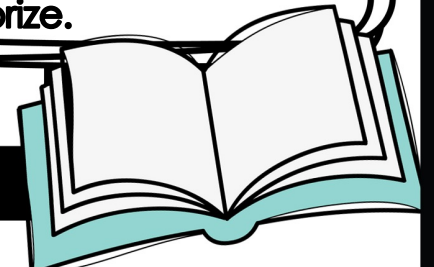
