THINGS TO KNOW

STANDARDS

Reading/Writing

- Read words that have inflectional endings (-ed, -ing, -s).
- Sort words into the correct syllable type when given a list of one-syllable and two-syllable words.

Math

- Understand subtraction as an unknown-addend problem within 20.
- Order three objects by length.
- Compare the length of two objects using a third object.
- Measure the length of an object using a shorter object (nonstandard measurement: paperclip, cube, etc.)

Social Studies

- Identify ways people adjust to their environment as well as modify their environment.
- Describe holidays and events and tell why they are commemorated in the United States.

Spelling

- CVCe (Super e)
 - game, same, ride, side
- Sight words
 - said, only, you, out, of, here
- CVCe +s
 - bakes, cakes, makes, takes, snakes, bikes, likes, hikes, hopes, ropes
