<u>Update – Wheatmore High School Confucius Classroom</u>

Deborah Trogdon-Stout, Assistant Principal and Dr. Chris Allred, Curriculum Support Instructor from Wheatmore High School gave a report from their recent visit to China along with an update from the Wheatmore High School's Confucius Classroom. Currently they have 37 students in Chinese I and 32 students will move on into Chinese II. Wheatmore High School plans to offer Chinese I, II, III and IV next school year. The class has joined with the Chinese class from High Point University where they met at a church and learned to cook Chinese food. There was also an open Forum held at the school with 60 participants in attendance to discuss future plans of the program. The Chinese Teacher, Jiao Feng, is here and a part of his salary is paid through the organization. They are in the process of renewing grants and writing additional grants. Ms. Patricia Foust thanked the Board of Education for this wonderful opportunity. She expressed we need to reach out for any experience we can give our students.
