READ THESE NOTES.

1. If the district is fractional, write the names of the children in each township separately under the name of the township, beginning with that township in which the schoolhouse or site is situated. A separate statement must be made to the clerks of the several townships in which the district is in part situated, giving the number of children five years of age and under twenty years residing in that part of the district lying within those respective townships. If possible make your list alphabetical.
2. If there is not space on this page sufficient to contain the names of all the children in the district, write the remainder upon the blanks 2a, provided for this purpose. If these blanks have not been furnished you, apply to your commissioner.
3. The ages of the children must be given as they are on June 1, 1917. If a child removes from the district during the fifteen days preceding June 1, he should be enrolled in the district in which he is resident June 1, 1917.
4. Where appropriate the names of pupils enrolled in the 7th or 8th grade, in the column provided, the number of the grade in which they have been enrolled during the year ending July 9, 1917. The total must agree with item 2a and 2b from of blank.
