SHED Competition (Student Hands-On Experience Day)

SHED (Student Hands-On Experience Day) is a real-world competition challenging students to put their academic and hands-on knowledge to the test. This contest involves a team of 6 students who are given a set of blueprints for an 8' x 12' utility building on the 1st morning. Teams then look over their plans and begin the building process. Teams are given 3 days to complete the building. The building includes floors, walls, rafters, roofs, shingles, siding, trim work, installation of 2 windows w/trim, and a steel double door. All phases of the building are inspected by certified building inspectors from across NC who have volunteered their time. Inspections encompass the same requirements as in building a residential home.

SWRHS has represented Randolph County well in the last 3 years since beginning participation in SHED. SWRHS has finished 3rd, 2nd, and 3rd in our 3 years. SHED exposes our students to contractors across our state and other building industry partners. I am pleased to say that a majority of our students have been offered jobs while participating in this event.
