PHS Important Update: New Wireless Device Policy Effective 2025–2026 School Year

6 What's Changing?

The **FOCUS Act** (Freeing Our Classrooms of Unnecessary Screens for Safety), passed by the Alabama Legislature, goes into effect at Prattville High School on the first day of school (August 7th, 2025). This new law **prohibits** the use of wireless communication devices during the school day.

Devices That Are Not Allowed During School Hours

These are considered wireless communication devices:

- Smartphones
- Smartwatches
- AirPods / Wireless Earbuds
- <u>I</u> Tablets & Laptops
- M Gaming Devices
- Pagers
- III Any device that can call, text, or access the internet

■ When Are Devices Allowed?

- On the bus to and from school
- Outside the school building at the bus or car rider line

When Are Devices Not Allowed?

No devices are allowed once students enter the building for the instructional day; they cannot be used again until students exit the building after the dismissal bell.

Storage Requirements

All devices must be:

- Powered OFF
- **Stored off-person** in a bookbag or lunchbox, purse, or extracurricular bag, or vehicle
- Not allowed in pockets or jackets all devices must be kept off-person.

Exceptions to the Policy

- A Chromebook is used for educational or learning purposes under the supervision of school personnel inside a classroom
- 🛣 Listed in a student's IEP, 504 Plan, or Individualized Health Plan
- Seed during a real emergency threatening safety
