Please

- Keep students who are ill home
- Keep student home if someone in the home is positive
- Call the nurse in either case so they can help address any quarantining concerns

Return to Normal

- Beecher 200U will open the school year under the same plan we ended the 2021-2022 school year.
 - Masking is up to the individual student and family
 - Positive cases will quarantine for 5 days.
 - Students who cannot wear a mask will quarantine for 10 days
 - There is NO remote learning for any non-quarantined students.
 - Classes and lunchrooms will return to capacity.

Vaccination Information

- District encourages individuals who are eligible to get the vaccine. The vaccine is NOT required
- The District may ask parents/guardians for proof of vaccination in specific circumstances (i.e. contact tracing)

Contact Tracing

- Continued required contact tracing
- Vaccinated not required to quarantine if asymptomatic
- With WCHD permission, quarantine lasts
 - 5 days for close contacts for students with <u>masking</u> when return, or
 - If eligible for test-to-stay.
 - School uses Binax Now Tests.
