7/17/2024

1. Conducted by Kevin Wilson, Superintendent, Dr. Rick Cardin, Principal
2. Discussed District Intruder Detection Audit Report findings
  - a. Phase 1 – gaining access was denied by all students that she encountered
  - b. Only two doors were found unlocked on the inside, one was a classroom that was switching teachers and the other was a door that isn't used.
  - c. Everything else went well
3. Discussed actions needed to correct audit; have teachers keep door locked
4. Raptor Service is up and running. Parent need to get used to brining in ID. Going well so far.
5. Discussed importance of community efforts in the case of a lockdown response
  - a. Do not need parents trying to run in until all clear, would add to the confusion
  - b. Nordheim does and has been using the Guardian Plan
  - c. School only has two phone lines, suggested to look into a possible third line that is not in use except in an emergency so that it stays open, parents calling in will make it hard to call out for needed help
  - d. Students trained for responses at beginning of year
  - e. HS students trained in CPR and Stop the Bleed during 2<sup>nd</sup> week of school
  - f. Discussed what some responses to threats might look like: outside versus inside threat
