MINUTES

The called meeting of the Sumter County Board of Education was called to order by Chairman Carolyn Hamilton with the following other members present: Abbis Bivins and Vincent Kearsse.

Rick Barnes, Patricia Harris and Sylvia Roland participated virtually.

A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Mr. Kearsse to adopt the agenda; second by Ms. Bivins; motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Mr. Kearsse to approve the following overnight out-of-state field trip request; second by Mrs. Harris:

Forty students (SCHS) to Orlando, Florida, April 7-9, 2022 for the senior trip and graduate bash.

A motion was made at 6:12 p.m. by Mr. Kearsse; second by Mrs. Harris to go into executive session for the following reasons as read by the chairman: to discuss or deliberate upon the appointment, employment, compensation, hiring, disciplinary action or dismissal, or periodic evaluation or rating of a public officer or employee or to interview applicants for the position of superintendent; (O.C.G.A. §50-14-3(b)(2) or to discuss or vote to authorize negotiations to purchase, dispose of, or lease property; authorize ordering an appraisal related to the acquisition or disposal of real estate; enter into a contract to purchase, dispose of, or lease property subject to approval in a subsequent public vote; or enter into an option to purchase, dispose of or lease real estate subject to approval in a subsequent public vote; (O.C.G.A. § 50-14-3(b)(1)). The motion carried unanimously.

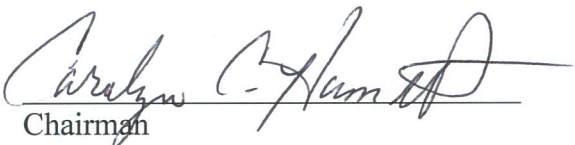
EXECUTIVE SESSION

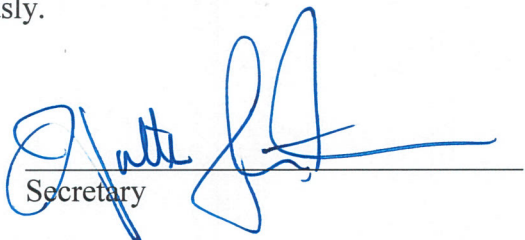
Mr. Barnes and Mrs. Roland logged into the meeting virtually during executive session.

After discussions in executive session, a motion was made at 7:28 p.m. by Mr. Kearsse; second by Mrs. Harris to return to open session; motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Kearsse offered a motion to accept the Sumter County Board of Education's recommendation of the appeal for student K.; second by Mr. Barnes. The motion carried five in favor (Mr. Kearsse, Mr. Barnes, Mrs. Hamilton, Mrs. Harris, and Mrs. Roland); one opposed (Ms. Bivins).

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:30 p.m. on a motion by Mr. Kearsse; second by Mr. Barnes; motion carried unanimously.
