## **Prior to Exam Day**

- Get a good night's rest before your exam and eat a nutritious breakfast.
- Make sure you have reviewed the <u>AP Terms and Conditions</u> prior to test day. Also review the <u>Exam Policies and Guidelines</u> at <u>apstudents.collegeboard.org/exam-policies-guidelines</u> for additional AP Exam information. On test day, you will sign the exam booklet to "accept" the terms & conditions.

### **Exam Day**

- → You are required to arrive no later than 30 minutes prior to your exam: 7:30 a.m. for the morning administration and 11:30 a.m. for the afternoon administration. STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ADMITTED AFTER THE EXAM BEGINS. Students may not be dismissed until an exam has officially ended; do not ask to leave early if you finish before the end of the exam. If you play a sport or have a job, it is your responsibility to inform your coach or employer of your AP exam obligation and make arrangements accordingly.
- → You are allowed (and encouraged) to bring a snack and beverage for your 10-minute break. However, food and drink are prohibited in the exam room. Afternoon exams (checking in at 11:30) will receive a sack lunch.
- → Bring a sweater/sweatshirt as it can get cold in the testing room.
- → Bring your government-issued (driver's license) or school-issued photo ID.
- → You are required to abide by the policies of both the College Board and Righetti High School during the exam period. Any misconduct will be reported and could jeopardize your AP Exam score.



### **BRING** the following items to the exam room:

- ☑ Two sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers) for completing multiple-choice answer sheets.
- ☑ **Two pens with black or dark blue ink only** for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams.
- ☑ A watch (in case your exam room does not have a clock that you can see easily).
- ☑ Up to two calculators with the necessary capabilities if you are taking an AP Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Microeconomics, Physics, or Statistics Exam. Visit apstudents.org/calculators for course specific calculator policy. PLEASE NOTE: The school will have some calculators available if you have a last-minute issue with yours but will not have enough on hand for all students.
- ☑ A ruler or straightedge only if you are taking an AP Physics Exam. (Protractors are not allowed.)
- ☑ If you are testing at a school different from the one you regularly attend, you must have your six-digit school code and a government-issued or school-issued photo ID. Home-schooled students will be provided with their state or country's home-school code at the time of the exam.
- ☑ If applicable, bring your College Board SSD Student Accommodation Letter which verifies that you have been approved for extended time or another testing accommodation.



## **DO NOT** bring the following to the exam room\*:

\* Electronic equipment of any kind: phones, smartwatches, or wearable technology of any kind, laptops, tablet computers, Bluetooth devices, portable listening or recording devices-MP3 player, iPod, etc.- cameras or other photographic equipment, devices that can access the Internet, separate timers of any type, and any other electronic or communication devices. CELL PHONES ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE TESTING ROOM\*.

\*Note: School-owned and controlled recording devices that meet AP Program criteria are allowed only for AP Spanish Language and Culture Exams.

- ✗ Books, compasses, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or notes.
- ✗ Mechanical pencils, No. 3 pencils, or colored pencils.
- \* Rulers or straightedges (these are allowed only for Physics exams).
- \* Protractors.
- Scratch paper (notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets or on scratch paper provided by the proctor).
- Computers or Calculators (except for AP Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Microeconomics, Physics or Statistics). See <u>apstudents.collegeboard.org/exam-policies-guidelines/calculator-policies</u> for course specific calculator policy.
- \* Reference guides, keyboard maps, or other typing instructions.
- × Watches that beep or have an alarm.
- **×** Clothing or shoes with subject-related information.
- × Ear plugs.
- × Clipboards.

\*Unless an item has been preapproved as an accommodation by the College Board Services for Students with Disabilities office prior to the exam date.
