SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
OCTOBER 23, 2025 @ 4:00 P.M.

The Webster County Board of Education held a special called meeting on October 23, 2025 at 4:00 p.m. Linda Rogers, Donald Brown, Jimmie Johnson, and James McCullough, Interim Superintendent, were present. Landon Matthews was absent.

Linda Rogers called the special called session to order at 4:00 P.M.

A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Board approved the tentative agenda for October 23, 2025. A motion was made by Donald Brown and seconded by Jimmie Johnson. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved to enter executive session to discuss or deliberate upon the appointment, employment, compensation, hiring, disciplinary action or dismissal or periodic evaluation or rating of a public officer or employee or to interview applicants for the position of Superintendent. A motion was made by Jimmie Johnson and seconded by Donald Brown to enter executive session. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved action taken in executive session to remove Dorothy Ingram from all Webster County Schools bank accounts at Citizens bank and to add James McCullough, Interim Superintendent to all bank accounts. The board also approved for all checks to require two signatures, James McCullough and Deidre Sterling. Deidre Sterling is already listed at the bank as a signer. A motion was made by Donald Brown and seconded by Jimmie Johnson. The motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 4:19 p.m. with a motion by Donald Brown and seconded by Jimmie Johnson. The motion carried unanimously.
