Sr. Adelangela Paita July 11, 1937 - July 3, 2025 Sister Adelangela Paita, born in 1937 in Calice al Cornoviglio, devoted her life to missionary service as a Consolata Sister. After taking her final vows in 1964, she began her journey in Kenya, later dedicating decades to uplifting Native American communities in the U.S., especially in Birmingham, Alabama. She founded the 91st Kateri Circle, championed the construction of The Blessed Kateri Tekawitha Shrine here at our parish, and tirelessly worked to affirm Indigenous identity within the Catholic Church. Sister Adelangela passed away in the Consolata Sisters' retirement home in Italy, leaving behind a legacy of compassion, cultural respect, and spiritual advocacy A C.
