


Mission Statement

Maddie Bell shares her experience of being a part of the program. "As a junior in high school, who has participated in the Regional Job Shadowing Program, it has been so much fun learning new things, meeting the nurses and staff, and experiencing opportunities that most high schoolers don't get. My experience at Danbury Hospital has been valuable in my learning. I have shadowed RNs (Registered Nurses) and PCTs (Patient Care Technicians) on the ortho/neuro/trauma unit for post/pre-ops. I cannot say enough about how great this program is and how it has influenced me.

As a junior in high school, I still have a long way to go, but I can say that I have a greater understanding of what it takes to become an RN or a PCT, what I want to do, what I don't want to do, and I've gained a better understanding of myself given this opportunity."


