Qualifications:

1. Verification of having attained, within the seven years immediately prior to hire, a minimum of 5,400 clock hours (three years) of acceptable part-time or full-time work experience in the technical education program area for which the certificate is sought as prescribed in Rule 290-3-2-.18(9).

3. Additional certification and license as an Alabama Cosmetology Instructor.
