MONTESSORI NEWS 4K - 2nd Grade

Our students have been learning about parts of a fish and fish poems/songs. Ask your child to tell you about their fish poem/song or to name the parts of a fish. 4K/5K can identify the head, eyes, tail, etc. 1st/2nd grade can name pectoral fin, pelvic fin, caudal fin, anal fin, head, etc.
