Progress Monitoring & Performance Dashboards Overview

The Progress Monitoring and Performance Dashboard modules are the heart of the PM2 system. These modules contain the reports that allow you to track both historical and up-to-the minute student performance, compare groups, plan for *AYP*, track assessment tools, and much more.

The reports in the Progress Monitoring and Performance Dashboard module are broken down by the type of data they contain. *The Performance Dashboard is generally only available to district leadership.*

Progress Monitoring

- <u>State Test Scores (Lagging Indicators)</u>: these reports display historical information from the state's high stakes testing
- <u>Local Test Scores (Leading Indicators)</u>: these reports display historical information from the state's high stakes testing
- <u>State & Local Test Scores (Lagging and Leading Indicators)</u>: these reports allow you to compare the historical data with the current year's data
- <u>Other Indicators</u>: these reports display scores from a variety of sources to get a full picture of the students' abilities. The reports included in this category vary from district to district, but typically include scores from tests such as SAT and ACT, *DIBELS*, Lexile, etc.
- <u>Leadership Indicators</u>: these reports allow you to compare large groups against the entire district and track progress

Performance Dashboards

- <u>State Comparisons</u>: these reports display historical information comparing district to district within the same state.
- <u>Faculty Performance</u>: these reports display real-time views of teachers classes & students and how they have performed and progressed.
- <u>State Test Readiness</u>: these reports display real-time views of the current school year's assessment testing as compared to historical state test to help analyze and determine of state test readiness.
