Reminders on what to submit for the 2026-2027

- Students entering **Preschool** need an updated Immunization Record, and a Physical/Dental Exam.
- Students entering **Kindergarten** need a Physical/Dental Exam, and an updated Immunization Record.
- Students entering **Third Grade** need a Dental Exam.
- Students entering **Seventh Grade** need a Physical/Dental Exam, and an updated Vaccination Record.

Some families have already turned in these documents. If you did **NOT** turn them in, please do so **before** the start of the school year. The district nurse comes in the 2nd week of school and will be going through all the students to make sure everything is turned in.

Once you have these documents you can....

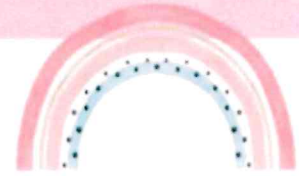

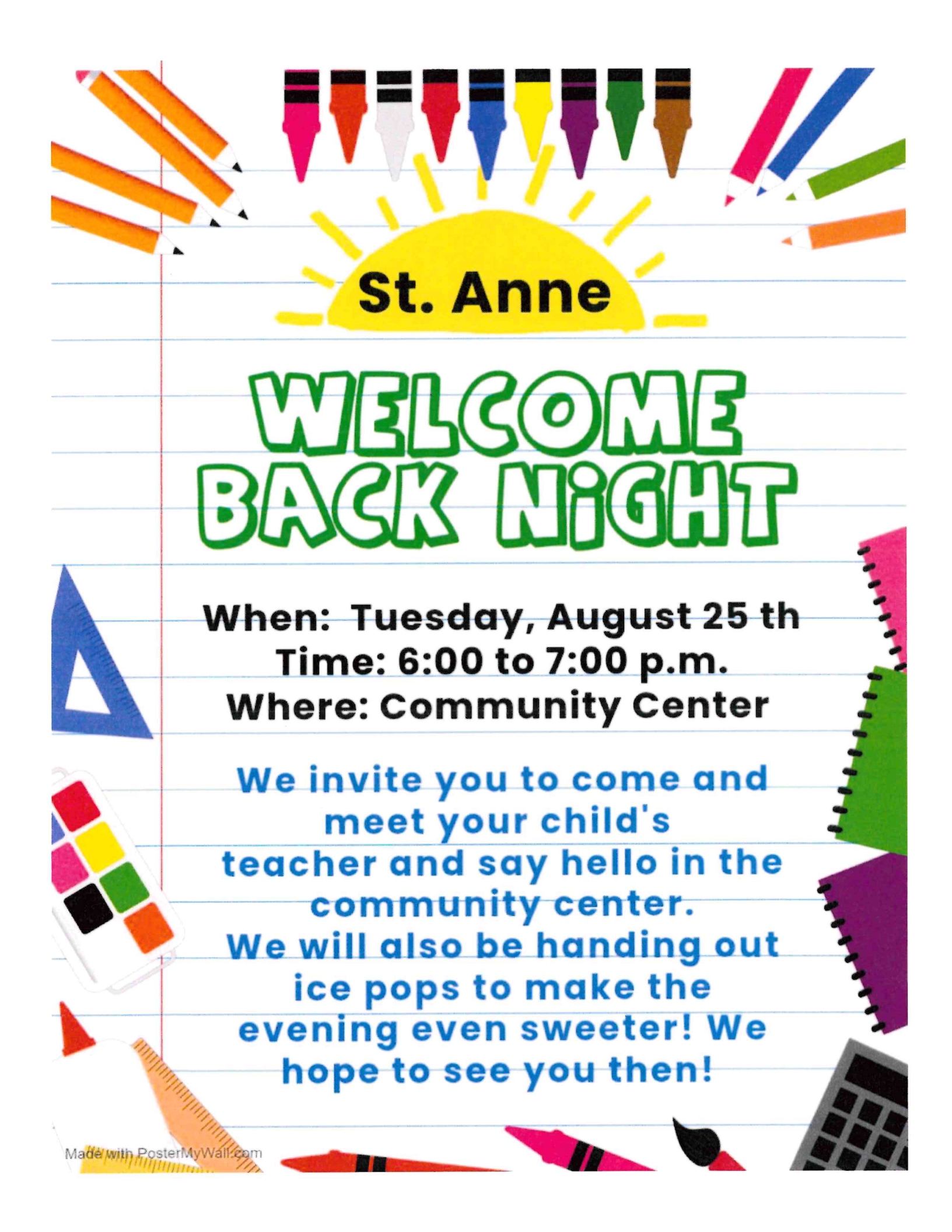

EXTENDED CARE POLICIES

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- You must re-register for Extended Care each year. Forms are attached. Please fill out the forms completely
- Registration fee is \$35.00 per child and due with the application
- Extended Care is open 7 AM to 9 AM and 2 PM to 5:30 PM
- St. Anne Extended Care uses ProCare for attendance and billing. If you are new to Extended Care you must create an account. Once you create an account ProCare will send you an invite email (check your spam), accept the invite and receive a pin #.
- Invoices will be sent via email on the 1st of every month with payment due no later than the 15th. For example: On October 1st you will receive an invoice for September. That invoice must be paid no later than October 15th.
- All Extended Care accounts MUST be on autopay. This means you must add to your ProCare account a checking, savings or credit card. Your child will not be allowed to go to Extended Care if you do not have autopay.
- Your child will not be able to attend Extended Care if you have a delinquent balance.
- Extended care is \$9.00.
- Every child who attends Extended Care must have a registration form on file.
