



## Medicaid Eligibility in Texas

### Regular Medicaid or CHIP:

- Must be 19 years or younger
- Must be a U.S Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Low income

### Special Circumstances for Medicaid over 19 year of Age

- ❖ *Medicaid for Pregnant Women or CHIP Perinatal*
  - Pregnant
  - Low income
  - Texas resident
- ❖ *Medicaid for Foster Youth Between 19-25*
  - Was in the foster system from 18 years of age or older
  - Had Medicaid while in foster care system
  - U.S Citizen or Permanent Resident
- ❖ *Medicaid for Children and Adults with Disabilities*
  - U.S Citizen or Permanent Resident
  - Low income
  - Have a disability
  - Already on Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
  - Already receive Home and Community-based Services (HCS) or Texas Home Living (TxHmL)
  - Have been placed in a nursing or care home for individual with intellectual disabilities
  - Age 65 or older or person who has a disability that is expected to last a year or longer
- ❖ *Medicaid for Adult Caring for a Child*
  - Related to the child being taken care of
  - The child is enrolled in Medicaid
  - Extremely low income
  - U.S Citizen or Permanent Resident

If you fall under any of these criteria, you or your children ***may*** be eligible for Medicaid.
