

## **Webster County School District Academic Plan for 2019-2020 (COVID-19)**

### **Kindergarten:**

- The Kindergarten Readiness Assessment (post-test) will not be administered.
- The English Language Proficiency Test (ELPT) will not be administered.
- Students will be promoted based on mastery of the standards taught during the first three nine weeks.
- Before any student is retained in kindergarten, a consensus among the parent, teacher, and administrator must be met.

### **First – Fifth Grades:**

- The Mississippi Academic Assessment Program (MAAP) and MAAP-Alternate will not be administered.
- The English Language Proficiency Test (ELPT) will not be administered.
- 4<sup>th</sup> 9 weeks, students will receive 100 participation grade in all subjects that will be used to calculate final average.

### **Sixth – Eighth Grades:**

- The Mississippi Academic Assessment Program (MAAP) and MAAP-Alternate will not be administered.
- The English Language Proficiency Test (ELPT) will not be administered.
- 4<sup>th</sup> 9 weeks, students will receive 100 participation grade in all subjects that will be used to calculate final average.

### **Ninth – Eleventh Grades:**

#### **Assessment:**

- The U.S. History, Biology I, Algebra I, and English II and MAAP-Alternate end-of-course assessments will not be administered.
  - If a student is currently enrolled in one of these four classes and he or she passes the course, the student will not be required to pass the assessment for graduation.
  - If a student has previously passed the course, but not the assessment, he or she will not be required to take the assessment in order to graduate.
- The English Language Proficiency Test (ELPT) will not be administered.
- The Career Planning and Assessment System (CPAS) will not be administered.
- 4<sup>th</sup> 9 weeks, students will receive 100 participation grade in all subjects that will be used to calculate final average
- Dual Credit\Dual Enrollment will follow Community College guidelines

## Twelfth Grade:

### Assessment:

- The U.S. History, Biology I, Algebra I, and English II and MAAP-Alternate end-of-course assessments will not be administered.
  - If a student is currently enrolled in one of these four classes and he or she passes the course, the student will not be required to pass the assessment for graduation.
  - If a student has previously passed the course, but not the assessment, he or she will not be required to take the assessment in order to graduate.
- The English Language Proficiency Test (ELPT) will not be administered.
- The Career Planning and Assessment System (CPAS) will not be administered.
- 4<sup>th</sup> 9 weeks, students will receive 100 participation grade in all subjects that will be used to calculate final average
- Dual Credit\Dual Enrollment will follow Community College guidelines
- Valedictorian and Salutatorian and Special Honors and Honors for 2019-2020 school year will be based up to the 3<sup>rd</sup> 9 weeks.
