The Fannin County Board of Education met in a work session with the following members present: Steve Stanley, Chair; Sandra Mercier, Vice-Chair; Bobby Bearden; and Lewis DeWeese. Terry Bramlett was absent.

Erik Cioffi, Fannin County High School Principal, provided the Board with an update on the proposed Early Graduation Policy. He also discussed the guidelines for converting letter grades to numeric grades for students who transfer in from other school systems. Mr. Cioffi shared with Board members the Five-Year Advanced Placement (AP) School Score Summary for Fannin County School System as compared to both Georgia and globally.

Art Hubbard, Assistant Superintendent, gave Board members an update on construction projects. Mr. Hubbard stated the structural steel is 95% complete, and the septic system has been installed for the new maintenance facility. Mr. Hubbard stated the structural steel installation was complete; the roof deck installation was complete; the roof insulation is 75% complete; the EPDM roofing installation is to be completed within 2 weeks; the exterior CMU is complete; the interior CMU is complete; the weather proofing of exterior walls is complete; the brick has been started and should be completed within 2 weeks; the installation of the roofing is to be completed within 10 days; the interior Plumbing rough is complete; the interior electrical rough is complete; all of the interior doorframes are set; all of the exterior doorframes are set; and the firewalls are 60% complete on the new CTAE classroom wing.

Mark Henson, Superintendent, reviewed the agenda for the meeting on Thursday, April 10, 2014.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, a motion was made by Bobby Bearden, seconded by Sandra Mercier, to adjourn subject to being called into special session by the Chair when deemed necessary. All members voted yes; motion carried.
