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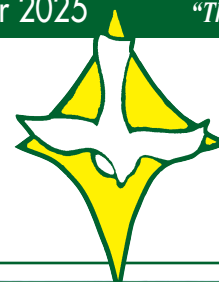

If you spend any amount of time at the Galilean Home, you'll quickly notice a group of individuals who seem to be everywhere at once. These on-site staff members wear more hats than anyone could list in a single breath—some serve as dorm moms, keeping the daily lives of residents running smoothly; others maintain detailed medical records, drive to countless appointments, or prepare and serve hot meals from scratch. And when a need arises—whether it's in their own dorm or across campus—they simply roll up their sleeves and pitch in.

Together, they help care for all 33 residents who call the Galilean Home their home. The residents range in age, ability, and background, but each is loved and valued. Many of the staff have been here for years—some for more than a decade—while others are newer to the work. What unites them is their shared love for the people they serve and their willingness to show up, day after day, with compassion and dedication.

They'll tell you the best part of their job is the residents themselves. "I love coming in to all the smiles and hugs," Mary shared. "They're a great joy to be around." For Amanda, it's "being the voice for those who can't speak for themselves" and seeing moments of pure joy—like when a resident was able to go to summer camp for the very first time.

The memories they carry are as varied as the roles they fill. Mariah recalls watching a resident happily sway to music in the morning, Karissa enjoys afternoons

on the porch with the residents, and Amy smiles at the thought of all the fun they've shared together over the years. Each moment serves as a reminder of why they do what they do.

They also want supporters to know just how much impact the Galilean Home has not only in meeting physical needs but in creating a true family. "Their love buckets are never empty," Mariah said. "No matter who you are or what you've been through, this is a place where everyone can have a home and a job to do," added Tamesha.

For those considering joining the team, the advice is heartfelt: embrace the chaos, be ready for anything, and know that the work, while challenging at times, is deeply rewarding. As Erla puts it, "It is a fulfilling thing to do." And in Amanda's words, "Every day we pray for God to guide our heart and give us joy, patience, grace, and compassion for God's special blessings."

The Galilean Home is more than buildings and programs, it's precious people...it's family. And the heartbeat of it all is these women, faithfully showing up every day to make sure that each of the 33 residents is cared for, known, and loved.
