



- As we kick off another exciting year, our Child Nutrition Team remains dedicated to providing nutritious, delicious meals to fuel student success. This year, we are proud to continue offering school breakfast and lunch at no cost, ensuring every student has access to the nutrition they need.
- Our **school breakfast program** provides balanced meals with whole grains, proteins, fruits, and low-fat dairy products. Research shows that children who eat a healthy breakfast are more attentive, perform better academically, and have improved overall health.
- Our school lunch program meets federal nutrition standards and offers a variety of choices to accommodate different tastes and dietary needs. Every meal includes a fruit or vegetable, helping students build healthy eating habits that can last a lifetime.





Student Meal Accounts

Each enrolled student is provided with a school meal account to track their meal participation and a la carte purchases.

Students can deposit money into their meal account using cash or check or through debit/credit cards using the MySchoolBucks app.

- Download the app or visit <u>myschoolbucks.com</u> and click on "Sign Up Free."
- Create a user profile with your email address, establish a password, and set up your security questions.
- Add a student to your account using the student's name, date of birth, and/or student ID number. (Some schools and districts may require either the student's date of birth or student ID number.)




