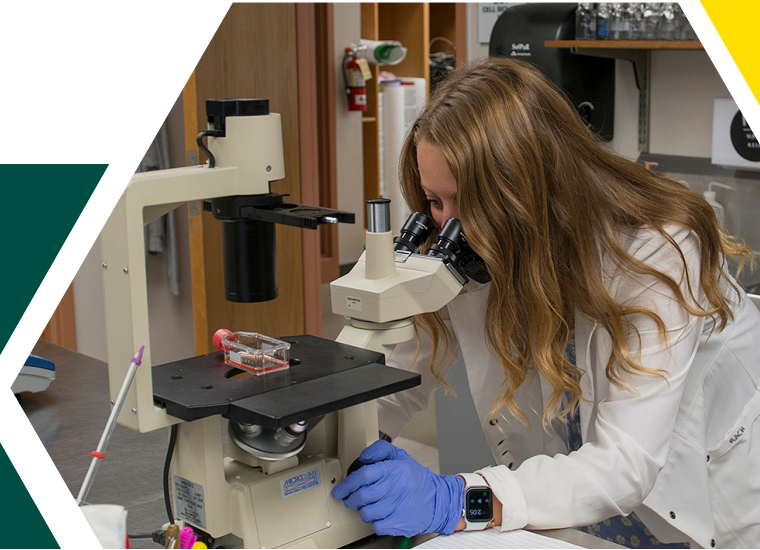

Apply if you:

- Have a GPA of 2.5+
- May have unmet financial need (Applicants must complete the FAFSA application to determine eligibility)
- Plan to enroll at least half-time (6 cr. per semester, 12 cr. per year)
- Hold U.S. citizenship, permanent residency or meet refugee criteria
- Will pursue a Bachelor of Science degree in one of the majors below
