Dear Parishioners,

What a wonderful weekend last weekend was! As I said, it is not often that a parish has a native son ordained, but to have two! The ordination itself was beautiful (and it was recorded and shared online). The Masses of Thanksgiving were powerful. Fr. Josh and Fr. Tanner are fine men, and I am certain that they will serve the Church well for many years.

Thank you to all who planned, prepared, served and cleaned up for the receptions. They were great tributes to the newly ordained. I am certain that the Thoof and Bot Families are thankful that they could just celebrate with the newly ordained.

This weekend we celebrate Pentecost – the descent of the Holy Spirit. While it was a history event that marked the 50th day after Jesus's resurrection and 10 days after His ascension, the power of Pentecost is that the Spirit intends to come upon every believer yet today. Pentecost is the birth of the Church, conceived in the wounded side of our pierced Lord, as the Church draws her first breath. But that 'oxygen' needs to get to every cell of the body – it cannot remain just at the head or heart. So, we need to seek the Holy Spirit, knowing that the Father longs to give us the Spirit. And as we will celebrate next week, the Spirit is a person, one of three persons in the one substance of the Holy Trinity.

As such, I recommend to your prayer, especially this weekend, the following prayer:

*"Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love.*

*Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And you shall renew the face of the earth.*

*O God, who by the light of the Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that by the same Holy Spirit we may be truly wise and ever enjoy his consolations. Through the same Christ Our Lord. Amen."*

### DOMINICAN FRIARS' MISSION APPEAL

Fr. Jerry Stookey from the St. Dominic Mission Society will be here on June 18 and 19. He is the director of the St. Dominic Mission Society.

St. Dominic Mission Society is the foreign mission organization of the Dominican Friars of the Province of St. Albert the Great (Central USA). Our principal foreign mission is in Puerto Rico.

Presently our greatest needs there are:

Casa de Predicación (House of Preaching) which is a retreat center in Bayamón severely damaged by Hurricane María in 2017. Funding is needed for restoration and especially for training catechists of children with disabilities.

Grade school and Dominican priory of our parish Nuestra Señora del Rosario in Yauco, which was severely damaged by a 6.7 magnitude earthquake in January 2020. The historic church has been successfully restored and opened in March 2022. However, funding is still needed, especially to restore and save our grade school.

We seek your prayers for our vocations and ministries in Puerto Rico, as well as your charitable donations for this mission. Thank you for your support and prayers.

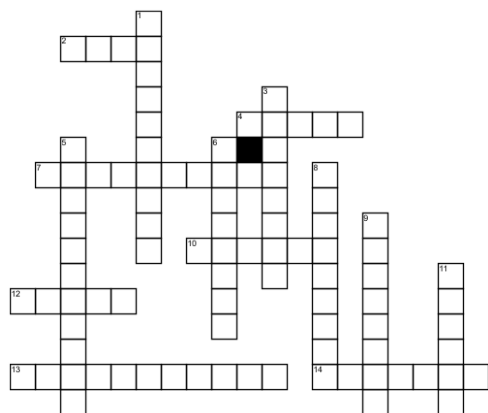

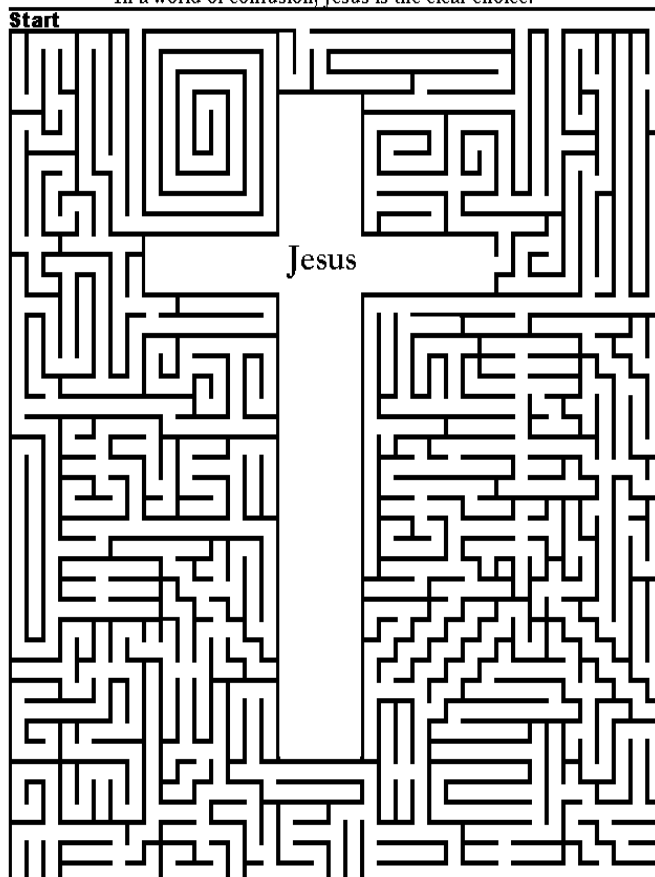
