Postsecondary Enrollment Options Acknowledgment of Counseling Prior to Enrollment

Wendell School District No. 232 Recognizes the importance of encouraging its secondary students to enroll full-time or part-time in nonsectarian courses or programs at eligible postsecondary institutions in order to promote rigorous academic pursuits and to provide a wider variety of options to secondary students. However, it is also important for students to understand that there are risks and possible consequences to enrolling in such courses. Therefore, prior to a student enrolling in courses at a postsecondary institution, this district, to the extent possible, provides counseling services to interested students and their parents/guardians to ensure that they are fully aware of such risks and possible consequences of postsecondary enrollment.
