School goal(s) and focus areas(s)

Our goal in Fifth Grade is to increase literacy. The goal is for our students to become literate adults who have the willingness and skills necessary for success throughout their lives.

Teachers, Parents, Students-Together for Success!

Teacher/School Responsibilities:

The teacher will send home important announcements and notes in take home folders and student planners. Student planners will be used to communicate feedback with parents on a weekly basis. Teachers will also send home interactive math newsletters with a description of upcoming topics. This explanation will be provided to give parents opportunities for involvement in their child's learning and education.

Family Responsibilities
