Language Arts: 4.0 credits

9th grade- English 9 I,II 1 credit

10th grade- English 10 I,II 1 credit

11th grade- American Literature I,II 1 credit

12th grade- British and World Literature I,II 1 credit

(College English 1101/1205 can take place of British Lit)

Social Studies: 4.0 credits

9th grade- Social 9 I, II (1 credit)

10th grade- American History I, II (1 credit)

11th grade- Economics/Careers I, II (1 credit)

12th grade- World History/Geography I,II (1 credit)

Science: 3.0 credits

9th grade- Science 9 I, II (1 credit)

10th grade- Biology I, II (1 credit)

11th grade - Chemistry I, II (1 credit)

(College CHEM 1100 can take place of Chem II)

Mathematics: 3.5 credits

9th grade- Algebra I, II (1 credit)

10th grade- Geometry I, II (1 credit)

10th- Introduction to Statistics (.5 credit)

11th- Adv. Algebra I, II (1 credit)

(College Algebra 1114 and College Trig 1116 are available senior year if interested)

Art: 1 credit

Students will be required to earn one credit in the area of the Arts

Other Requirements: 3 credits

Phy Ed- 9th grade PE, and one PE class in grades 10-12 (1 credit total)

Life Skills/Personal Finance/Careers- 9th grade/6 week rotation (.5 credit)

Health- 9th grade (.5 credit)

FACS- In grades 10-12, Students choose one of three classes in Child Development I, Child Development II, or Family Life Skills and Relationships (.5 credit)

Technology- In grades 9-12, Students must take an approved technology class, recommended course is Computer Applications (.5 credit)

Elective credits: 7.5 required elective credits

If a student does not fail or need to re-take a class for any reason, they would have the opportunity to take 9.5 credits of elective classes.
