

REPORT CARD UPDATE

Dear Parents and Guardians:

Although our original calendar has report cards scheduled to be sent home today, we feel that it is imperative that we incorporate some additional instructional time for our students in order to obtain an accurate level of achievement. Our students missed 10 instructional days during this 9-week grading period. Therefore, they will be allowed an opportunity to receive 10 additional days of instruction. This additional instruction period will begin on October 18, 2021 and end on October 29, 2021. Although after-school programs will be offered during this period, students will not be required to stay after school. With that being said, the new date for report cards to be sent home will be November 2, 2021. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact your child's school for clarification.

As we attempt to return all students to school on October 18, 2021, we will continue the weekly COVID-19 testing. If you have not given permission for the weekly testing, please do so in order to protect your child(ren) and others. As I mentioned in an earlier update, students in grades Pre-K through second (2nd) will be swabbed by mouth. All other students will receive a nasal swab at the tip of the inside of the nostril.
