SIGHT WORDS

Please continue reviewing sight words with your child at home at least two times a week. I am seeing great progress in the classroom!

THINGS TO KNOW

School Drop Off/Pickup: School drop off and pick up is at the front of the building. Please do not drop off/pick up students in the back of the school where the busses are.

After school plans: If your child's after school plan is different from what they usually do, you must notify the school.

Toys: Please make sure your child leaves all toys and trinkets at home!

Snacks: If your child wishes to bring a snack for their birthday celebration, it must be off the approved snack list.

STANDARDS

Reading/Writing

- Your child will be able to describe characters, settings, and major events in a fictional story, with details.
- Your child will be able to determine the central message or lesson in a fictional story.
- Your student will be able to answer who, what, why, when, where, and how from a fictional story with details and with help from a graphic organizer.

Math

- Your child will be able to understand the meaning of the equal sign and determine if the equations, using addition and subtraction, are true or false.
- Your student will be able to use properties of operations as strategies to add and subtract within 20 (commutative property, associative property).

Science

- Your child will understand how humans mimic plants and/or animals by using their external parts to help them survive, grow, and meet their needs.

Social Studies

- Your child will be able to identify individuals who are helpful to people in their everyday lives.
- Your child will name some responsibilities that students have at home and school.
