SEEKING BAPTISM CLASS LEADERS

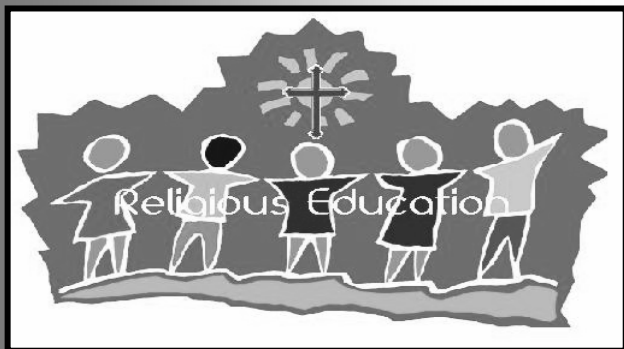
