Rappahannock County Public Schools recently participated in a voluntary State program to test our Rappahannock County Elementary School's drinking water for lead. This program was offered to all Virginia public schools and child care facilities and specifically tests water fixtures that provide drinking or cooking water to students.

In Rappahannock County Elementary School, a total of 158 fixtures were tested. None of those fixtures present lead levels that exceed the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)'s action level of 15 parts per billion (ppb).
