Dear Parent/Guardian:

T.C.A. 49-6-5001 (c)(1) states, "no children shall be permitted to attend any public school, ... until proof of immunization is given to the admissions officer of the school."

• This TN Department of Health immunization rule went into effect July 1, 2010.

Your child lacks an up to date record of immunization at
Your child needs:
Correct form (state required)
Tdap (combination vaccine that protects against three diseases: tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis
(whooping cough).
Varicella
MMR
Other
Students who do not have up to date immunizations will not be allowed to attend school for the 2024-2025
school year (7th grade), until the school receives a current and completed state required Tennessee Department
of Health Certificate of Immunization form.
Parents can request a medical or religious exemption from the immunization requirements.
Medical – Physician (MD, DO) or department Public Health Nurse authorized to indicate specific vaccines medical exempted (because of risk of harm) on the new form.
Religious – This exemption requires a signed statement by the parent/guardian that vaccination(s) conflicts with their religious tenets or practices. You may use the Vaccine Religious Exemption Form that can be found at https://www.dekalbschools.net/coordinatedschoolhealth under Forms.
