ACADEMICS, SPIRITUALITY, ARTS, and ATHLETICS

Our faculty, staff, and administration worked tirelessly to maintain our high academic standards. Teachers were able to use Google Classroom and in-person instruction and we made adjustments throughout the year to in-person instruction to provide the best learning and student life possible.

The Class of 2021 exemplifies the outstanding results of our exceptional efforts:

In spite of COVID-19, our curricular and extra-curricular activities continued to thrive.

- Indoor Track & Field team was successful at the State Meet taking:
 - 1st Place in the boys 4x800 Relay team
 - 2nd place in the individual 3200 for both boys and girls
- Several individual new school records were set by athletes in various sports
- The Varsity Wrestling team qualified for State for the first time in school history
- Several athletes from multiple sports named to All-Metro and All-State Teams
- A new state-sanctioned E-Sport sport team
- Additional expansion of our athletic facilities and field lighting allowed home games to be played on campus for Varsity and JV Soccer for the first time in school history
- Individual State Champions - Girls Singles and Doubles Tennis
- Swim Individual State Champs - 100 Breaststroke; 3rd Place 200 Freestyle Relay; 3rd Place in Women's Dive
- Boys Outdoor Track & Field State Champs 4 x 800 Relay; 3rd Place in 4 x 400 Relay
- Girls Outdoor Track & Field Individual State - 2nd Place 3200M and 1600M; 3rd Place in 4 x 400 Relay
- Boys Soccer Team advanced to State Sweet Sixteen

Although we could not serve the community through the traditional in-person approach, we were able to continue our commitment to service with several drives for community organizations.

- 11,200 Hours of Community Service for Class of 2021
- Collected medical supplies for new Clinica Medica Moscati
- Collected baby good items for local non-abortion pregnancy clinic
- Provided Christmas presents to more than 40 foster children in North Alabama through the Angel Tree gift

OPERATIONAL VITALITY

True to our Catholic mission that welcomes all, we require less in tuition dollars than it costs to educate each student. This year our scholarship granting organizations were not able to fully fund student support. Strained by additional expenses due to opening the school during the pandemic, our resulting shortfall was approximately \$500,000.

Through hardwork and dedication, the *Helping Hands, Giving Hearts* campaign, led by Dr. Russell, our students, the Parent Association, our alumni, and the development office, raised an amazing \$311,288. The Falcon Booster Club held a successful hybrid Dancing with the Falcons in the Spring, raising more than \$25,000 to support continued athletic facilities improvements.

Through the facilities fee, we kept up with repairs and maintenance and have established a reserve to provide for any future capital needs of the current building and facilities.

This year's campus upgrades included:

- Field lights for the football/soccer and softball fields
- Additional access points and network hardware to support broadband
- Repaired and upgraded the campus irrigation system
- Purchased moveable bleachers for outdoor home games
- Completed field complex site work for gravel pathway
- Installed additional electric capacity for athletic fields
- Replaced 3 inoperable HVAC units

Even during a pandemic, community outreach persisted:

- JP II hosted a January luncheon for the parish DREs and Church administration
- JP II students were represented and/or spoke at every parish Mass during Catholic Schools Week
