Things to Know for the 2022-2023 School Year

- **Cleaning Protocols:** Buildings will be cleaned and sanitized daily or as often as needed to prevent contamination or virus transmission. Protecting our students, teachers, and staff from infection is critical to ensuring that instruction continues without interruption. Schools will continue to encourage proper hygiene practice, such as washing hands regularly and using hand sanitizer. Students and staff should self-monitor daily for COVID-19 symptoms.
- Vaccinations: COVID-19 vaccinations are not required for employees or students. The Toombs County Health Department, as well as the local hospital, pharmacies, and doctor offices, has COVID-19 vaccines available.
- Individuals with COVID-19: Students and staff who are diagnosed with COVID-19 will be required to follow the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines. Currently, the CDC guidelines state that individuals who test positive for COVID-19 should stay home and isolate for at least 5 days. - **Quarantines/Contact Tracing:** Per <u>CDC</u> guidance, isolating for exposure is no longer required.
- Special Events/Visitors: Field Trips, assemblies, and other school events will resume as normal.
