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The Louisville Municipal School District's Office of Support Services is seeking to employ the following individuals during the 2022-23 academic school year:

- (a) Interventionist(s) to provide strategies and assistance to public school students identified as needing to improve communication, reading, and/or language skills. Interventionist(s) will serve students in grades preschool - 6th grade. The Interventionist will work part time, up to four days per week, no more than four hours per day, for the 2022-23 academic school year and be paid at a rate of \$25 dollars per hour. Candidates must hold a minimum of an Associate's degree, or 48 hours of verifiable college credits from an accredited college or university, or a silver or gold certificate on the Work Keys test.
- (b) Speech/Language Pathologist to provide service and support for public school students from 3 years of age - 6th grade who have been identified as needing to improve communication and/or language skills. SLP must be licensed by the Mississippi Dept. of Ed. and will work part-time, as needed. A copy of your current license is required for consideration.
