STUDENT AUTOMOBILE USE

Student use of an automobile on school grounds is a privilege. Careless driving is prohibited and is subject to school disciplinary action. Anyone guilty of careless driving may be reported to the police.

Improper use of a motor vehicle on school grounds can result in suspension from school. Driving a motor vehicle from school grounds during the school day without authorization will be considered improper use of a motor vehicle and will be considered grounds for suspension. Parking at the school is a privilege granted by the school and the privilege will be withdrawn if it is abused. Prior to driving or parking on school grounds, students will be required to register motor vehicles in the main office. If a student leaves the school grounds in a motor vehicle without authorization, parents will be notified and the student will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including suspension from school.

Automobiles must be parked in the designated parking area. Students, including the driver, are not allowed in vehicles during school hours, except for arrival or departure. Drivers and their passengers must leave the vehicle as soon as they arrive at school and are not to be in it until they leave school again.
