# Lockers

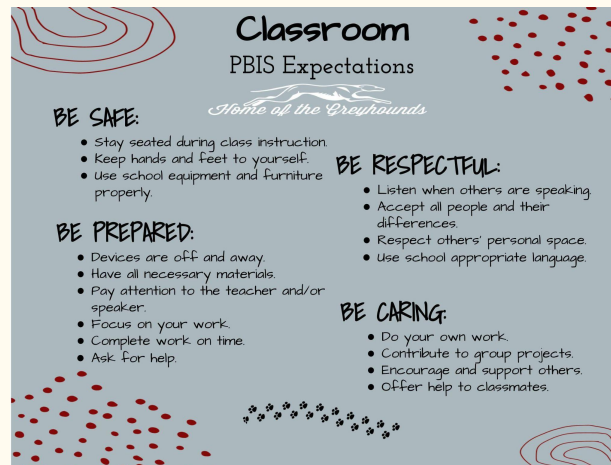

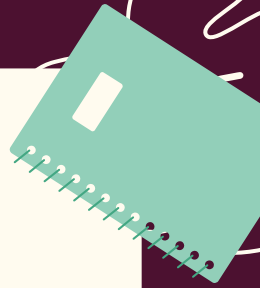

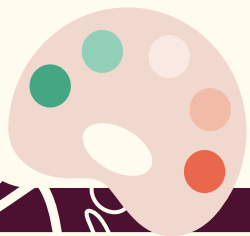
